FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Greetings to you from St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park! This last week, classes resumed at the seminary following the summer break. On Monday afternoon, Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco, celebrated a special Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit to mark the beginning of the academic year. All the seminarians and faculty members participated in the Mass. Those of us who are priests con-celebrated the Mass with the Archbishop. In his homily, Archbishop Cordileone quoted from Pope Benedict XVI's address to Catholic educators during his visit to the United States in April 2008. In his talk, the Holy Father noted:

Education is integral to the mission of the Church to proclaim the Good News. First and foremost every Catholic educational institution is a place to encounter the living God who in Jesus Christ reveals his transforming love and truth (cf. *Spe Salvi*, 4). This relationship elicits a desire to grow in the knowledge and understanding of Christ and his teaching. In this way those who meet him are drawn by the very power of the Gospel to lead a new life characterized by all that is beautiful, good, and true; a life of Christian witness nurtured and strengthened within the community of our Lord's disciples, the Church.

Archbishop Cordileone spoke about the importance of the seminarians having a deep friendship with Jesus and allowing Him to lead them to greater holiness. To bring the point home, at the end of Mass, we participated in a Eucharistic procession around the entrance grounds of the seminary. Whenever we participate in a Eucharistic procession, we are reminded that Jesus is leading and we are following. And to follow, we have to be attentive and docile to his leadership.

As we begin a new academic year, I think of our students and teachers at Notre Dame School and in our religious education program. Also, I think of those who attend one of the many public schools in Vacaville and the students at St. Patrick St. Vincent High School in Vallejo. I think of our parishioners who attend the Valley of the Sacred Heart Academy and the Chesterton Academy in Dixon. Last academic year, with all the COVID restrictions, in-class instruction was especially daunting for our students, teachers and administrators. This year is starting out with some of the same challenges. But if we stay focused on Jesus, He will lead us through. The sea may be rough, as the apostles experienced when they were out fishing, but they were consoled that Our Lord was with them. The more we are "drawn by the very power of the Gospel to lead a new life characterized by all that is beautiful, good, and true," as Pope Benedict said, the more Jesus will live in us and work

through us.

St. Monica, whose feast day was on Friday, certainly knew that. She was the faithful mother of St. Augustine who never stopped praying for his conversion. Her patience and perseverance paid off towards the end of her life, when her son repented of his sinful ways and was baptized. Eventually, Augustine became one of the greatest Doctors of the Church. St. Monica could pray for her son because she loved Jesus with all her heart and trusted that Our Lord was in charge. St. Monica's beautiful witness is important not only for all mothers, but also for all fathers. Parents, through your prayerfulness, perseverance and holy example, you will bring your children to Jesus and help them grow in friendship with Him. On the cover of this bulletin is a copy of a painting of St. Monica and her son. Their close friendship is evident in their body language. But their body language also points to their friendship with Christ. Mother and son gaze towards the heavens as if they both know that what binds them together is their Creator and Redeemer. They recognize Jesus in each other and know that their ultimate destiny is to be united with Him, the Father and Holy Spirit eternally in heaven. As we make our own pilgrimage through this new academic year, may we keep our eyes fixed on Christ and our hearts and minds focused on our ultimate destination.

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

As I mentioned previously in this bulletin, I have decided to go ahead with the plan to have sound panels installed around each of the upper 12 windows (6 on each side) in the nave. It is expected that the sound panels will help to limit the sound echo in the church and improve peoples' comprehension of what is actually being proclaimed, prayed and preached from the sanctuary. Over the last five years, if I received a dollar for every time someone told me that he or she couldn't understand my words, I would be a rich man indeed.

In order to assist with the project, I asked Don Krch to contact three companies and ask them for quotes of how much it would cost to construct the panels and install them. After receiving the three quotes, I shared them with the members of the Finance Council. The Finance Council members recommended that I go with the lowest of the quotes which is around \$40K. In order to help to cover the cost of the sound panels, I decided to have a second collection the weekend of September 11th and 12th. To be sure, forty thousand dollars is a lot of money. However, I think you would agree that it is a worthy investment. If one can't hear what is being said at church, it can make going to church a rather frustrating experience. Thank you in advance for your generosity in supporting this important project!

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

¡Saludos desde el Seminario de San Patricio en Menlo Park! Esta semana, las clases reanudaron en el seminario después de vacaciones de verano. El lunes por la tarde, el Arzobispo Salvatore Cordileone de San Francisco, celebró una Misa Votiva especial del Espíritu Santo para marcar el comienzo del año académico. Todos los seminaristas y profesores participaron en la Misa. Los que somos sacerdotes celebramos la Misa con el Arzobispo. En su homilía, el Arzobispo Cordileone citó el discurso del Papa Benedicto XVI a los educadores Católicos durante su visita a los Estados Unidos en abril del 2008. En su discurso, el Santo Padre señaló:

La educación es parte integral de la misión de la Iglesia de proclamar la Buena Nueva. En primer lugar, toda institución educativa católica es un lugar para encontrarse con el Dios vivo quien en Jesucristo revela su transformador amor y verdad (cf. Spe Salvi, 4). Esta relación provoca un deseo de crecer en el conocimiento y la comprensión de Cristo y su enseñanza. De esta manera, aquellos que lo conocen son atraídos por el poder mismo del Evangelio para llevar una nueva vida caracterizada por todo lo que es hermoso, bueno y verdadero; una vida de testimonio cristiano nutrida y fortalecida dentro de la comunidad de discípulos de nuestro Señor, la Iglesia.

El Arzobispo Cordileone habló sobre la importancia de que los seminaristas tengan una profunda relación con Jesús y le permitan conducirlos a una mayor santidad. Para llevar el punto a su lugar, al final de la Misa, participamos en una procesión eucarística alrededor de los terrenos de la entrada del seminario. Cada vez que participamos en una procesión eucarística, se nos recuerda que Jesús nos está guiando y nosotros estamos siguiendo. Y por consiguiente, tenemos que estar atentos y dóciles a su liderazgo.

Al comenzar un nuevo año académico, pienso en nuestros estudiantes y maestros en la Escuela Notre Dame y en nuestro programa de educación religiosa. Además, pienso en aquellos que asisten a una de las muchas escuelas públicas en Vacaville y los estudiantes de la escuela secundaria San Patricio San Vicente en Vallejo. Pienso en nuestros feligreses que asisten a la Academia del Valle del Sagrado Corazón y a la Academia Chesterton en Dixon. El año académico pasado, con todas las restricciones por el COVID, las clases en persona fueron especialmente desalentadora para nuestros estudiantes, maestros y administradores. Este año comienza con algunos de los mismos retos. Pero si nos mantenemos enfocados en Jesús, Él nos guiará. El mar puede ser violento, como los apóstoles experimentaron cuando estaban pescando, tenían el consuelo de que Nuestro Señor estaba con ellos. Cuanto más nos sintamos "son atraídos por el poder mismo del Evangelio para llevar una nueva vida caracterizada por todo lo que es hermoso, bueno y verdadero", como dijo el Papa Benedicto, más Vivirá Jesús en nosotros y obrará a través de

nosotros.

Santa Mónica, cuya festividad fue el viernes pasado, sin duda lo sabía. Fue la fiel madre de San Agustín quien nunca dejó de orar por su conversión. Su paciencia y perseverancia dieron sus frutos al final de su vida, cuando su hijo se arrepintió de su forma pecaminosa y fue bautizado. Con el tiempo, Agustín se convirtió en uno de los más grandes Doctores de la Iglesia. Santa Mónica pudo orar por su hijo porque amaba a Jesús con todo su corazón y confiaba en que Nuestro Señor estaba a cargo. El hermoso testimonio de Santa Mónica es importante no solo para todas las madres, sino también para todos los padres. Padres, a través de su oración, perseverancia y ejemplo santo, acercarán a sus hijos a Jesús y los ayudarán a crecer en su relación con Él. En la portada de este boletín hay una réplica de una pintura de Santa Mónica y su hijo. Su estrecha amistad es evidente en su lenguaje corporal. Pero su lenguaje corporal también apunta a su relación con Cristo. Madre e hijo miran hacia los cielos como si ambos supieran que lo que los une es su Creador y Redentor. Reconocen a Jesús el uno en el otro y saben que su destino final es estar unidos con Él, el Padre y el Espíritu Santo eternamente en el cielo. Estimados feligreses de Santa María,

Como mencioné anteriormente en este boletín, he decidido seguir adelante con el plan de instalación de paneles de sonido alrededor de cada una de las 12 ventanas superiores (6 a cada lado) en la iglesia. Se espera que los paneles ayuden a limitar el sonido de eco en la iglesia y ayudar a que la gente entienda lo que realmente se está proclamando, orando y predicando desde el santuario. De hecho, durante los últimos cinco años, si hubiera recibido un dólar por cada vez que alguien me ha dicho que él o ella no pudo entender mis palabras, yo sería un hombre rico.

Con el fin de ayudar con el proyecto, le pedí a Don Krch que se comunicara con tres compañías y les pidiera presupuestos para ver cuánto costaría construir los paneles e instalarlos. Después de recibir los tres presupuestos, los compartí con los miembros del Consejo de Finanzas. Los miembros del Comité de Finanzas me recomendaron que me fuera con el presupuesto más bajo, el cual es alrededor de \$40K. Con el fin de ayudar a cubrir el costo de los paneles de sonido, decidí tener una segunda colecta el fin de semana del 11 y 12 de septiembre. Sin duda, cuarenta mil dólares es mucho dinero. Sin embargo, creo que ustedes estarían de acuerdo en que se trata de una inversión que vale la pena. Si uno no puede escuchar lo que se dice en la iglesia, puede hacer que ir a la iglesia sea una experiencia bastante frustrante. ¡Gracias de antemano por su generosidad en su apoyo a este importante proyecto!

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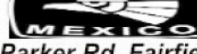
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
