FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Wednesday, February 17th, marks the beginning of Lent. Please see our schedule of Ash Wednesday Masses elsewhere in the bulletin. While Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation, participating in Mass (in-person or otherwise) is certainly worthy of praise and an excellent way to begin Lent. This year, on account of the pandemic, for the distribution of the ashes, we are being asked to pray the formula one time over everyone ("Remember man you are dust and unto dust you shall return") and then we priests and other ministers will sprinkle the ashes on the crowns of your heads as you come forward. While receiving ashes on our heads seems foreign to us in the United States, it is more usual in Europe. If you look at photos of the recent popes receiving ashes on Ash Wednesday you will notice that they receive the ashes on the crowns of their heads. During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross in English at 6p and in Spanish at 7p on Fridays. Also, the Sacrament of Penance will be available on Thursday evenings between 5p and 6:15p, in addition to the usual other times that confessions are heard: Tuesdays between 5:30p and 6:30p and Saturdays from 3:30p to 4:45p. 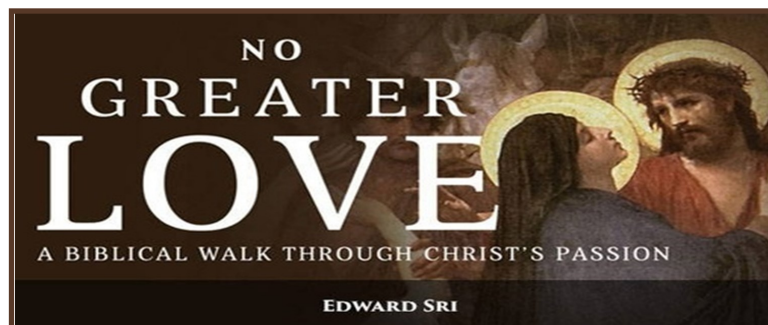

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

El miércoles 17 de febrero marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma. Por favor, vea nuestro horario de Misas del Miércoles de Ceniza en el boletín. Si bien el Miércoles de Ceniza no es un día de precepto, participar en la Misa (en persona o de otra manera) es ciertamente digno de alabanza y una excelente manera de comenzar la Cuaresma. Este año, a causa de la pandemia, para la distribución de las cenizas, se nos pide que recemos la fórmula una vez sobre toda la congregación ("Recuerda que eres polvo y en polvo te has de convertir") y entonces nosotros, los sacerdotes y otros ministros espaciaremos las cenizas en sus cabezas a medida que se vayan acercando. Aunque recibir cenizas en nuestras cabezas nos parece algo extraño en los Estados Unidos, es más común en Europa. Si nos fijamos en las fotos de los recientes papas cuando reciben cenizas el Miércoles de Ceniza se darán cuenta de que reciben las cenizas en sus cabezas. Durante la Cuaresma, tendremos el Via Crucis en inglés a las 6p y en español a las 7p, los viernes. También, el Sacramento de la Penitencia estará disponible los jueves por la tarde entre las 5p y las 6:15p, además de los horarios habituales en que se escuchan las confesiones: martes entre las 5:30p y las 6:30p y los sábados de 3:30p a 4:45p. 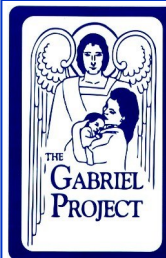
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
