FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As some of you may be aware, one of our 8 weekend Masses is the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM) or Extraordinary Form (EF) Mass, which is offered every Sunday at 2p. The TLM has a relatively long tradition at St. Mary's. Recently, I saw Fr. Francis Stevenson who served as Parochial Vicar with Fr. McFadden during the first decade of the 2000's. Fr. Stevenson asked me if we were still offering the TLM at St. Mary's Parish. It was Fr. Stevenson who started celebrating the TLM at St. Mary's shortly after the promulgation of the *motu proprio* "Summorum Pontificum" (SP) of Pope Benedict XVI in 2007. SP made the TLM more accessible to the faithful, not only to those who remember it from when it was celebrated prior to 1970, but also to younger folks who have experienced and come to appreciate the Mass over the years. More recently, in July, Pope Francis promulgated a *motu proprio* called "Traditionis Custodes" (TC). "Traditionis Custodes" is translated "Guardians of the Tradition". (A "motu proprio" is simply an edict that is promulgated by the pope by his own initiative.) In a nutshell, the *motu proprio* "SP" of Pope Benedict XVI freed up the celebration of the TLM for priests and the faithful, while the *motu proprio* "TC" of Pope Francis has placed some restrictions on the celebration of the TLM.

Above all, with TC, Pope Francis underlined the authoritative role that Catholic bishops have in their own dioceses for ensuring that the TLM is celebrated faithfully and properly. In the Diocese of Sacramento, the TLM is celebrated every day at St. Stephen, the First Martyr Parish in Sacramento. St. Stephen's Parish is served by priests of the Fraternity of St. Peter, a congregation dedicated to the celebration of the TLM according to the 1962 Missal and the other sacraments under the traditional form. There is one other church in the Diocese where the TLM is celebrated (officially) weekly on Sundays: St. Mary's Parish, Vacaville. Bishop Soto has indicated to me that he is inclined to allow the TLM to continue at our parish. After all, the TLM does have a long history of being celebrated in Vacaville, either at St. Mary's or at St. Joseph's.

I give this background to the history of the TLM in Vacaville by way of introduction to writing about the special TLM that we will host on Thursday, October 21st at 6p. On the 21st, we will have a "Pontifical Solemn High (EF/TLM) Mass" celebrated by Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco. We started planning for this Mass about a year ago, when parishioner Jason Suarez asked if we might try to have this special Mass. At Jason's suggestion, we decided to invite Archbishop Cordileone, since he has celebrated this type of complicated Mass before. Therefore, I requested and received permission from Bishop Soto to invite Archbishop Cordileone to our parish. Please know that you are most welcome to attend this Mass. It will last longer than a usual Sunday Mass, probably somewhere between 90 minutes and two hours. In any case, we plan to live-stream the Mass; thus, it will be available on our "St. Mary's Vacaville" YouTube page. Why have this special Mass on October 21st? October 21st is the Feast Day of Blessed Karl of Austria. Who was Blessed Karl? Born in 1887 in Austria, Karl eventually married, and together with his wife Zita raised a family of 8 children in the Catholic faith. Karl and

Zita were faithful and devoted Catholics. In 1916, during World War I, Karl was made the Emperor of Austria and King of Hungary. He was a fair and just ruler, but only three years later, at the end of WWI, in 1919, Blessed Karl was exiled as a result of the fallout from the end of the war and the change of political leadership. Karl suffered an illness and died in 1922 on Madeira Island, Portugal, 320 miles west of Morocco.

In an article from the *Osservatore Romano* (October 3, 2004), Cardinal Christoph Schönborn, Archbishop of Vienna, wrote the following about Blessed Karl:

After assuming power [Karl] strove to alleviate the horrors of war he saw, and took concrete steps to bring about peace. As emperor he understood peace to be his absolute, kingly duty. In his ascension manifesto, therefore, he named peace as his central goal. Only Karl took up the peace proposal of Pope Benedict XV, incorporating its principles in a set of proposed peace accords (which historians have evaluated as thoroughly realistic and having had great potential). All of these efforts failed in the long run because of the peace-through-victory delusion decided by his German ally policy-makers (Hindenburg, Ludendorff) and because of the anti-peace party of the Entente. Karl was ready to make considerable sacrifices for peace and, even after his removal from power, he wholly strove to arrange for the peace and stability of his peoples and all nations of Europe. His attempts to return to power in Hungary were undertaken at the request of the pope who was concerned with the stability and liberty there (his concerns were justified!). The emperor saw his fatal suffering as a sacrificial offering for peace and unity in Central Europe.

Living at a time when we could truly benefit from faithful Catholic civil leaders, Blessed Karl serves as a good reminder that political leadership and holiness can be achieved. Blessed Karl, pray for us!

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Como algunos de ustedes puede que sepan, una de nuestras 8 Misas del fin de semana es la Tradicional Misa en Latin (TML) o La Misa de Forma Extraordinaria (FE), la cual se ofrece todos los domingos a las 2pm. La TML tiene una tradición relativamente larga en Santa María. Recientemente, me encontré con el Padre Francis Stevenson quien sirvió como Vicario Parroquial con el Padre McFadden durante la primera década de 2000. El Padre Stevenson me preguntó si todavía estábamos ofreciendo la TML en la Parroquia de Santa María. Fue el Padre Stevenson quien comenzó a celebrar la TML en Santa María poco después de la promulgación de *motu proprio* "Summorum Pontificum" (SP) del Papa Benedicto XVI en 2007. SP hizo que la TML fuera más accesible para los fieles, no solo para aquellos que la recuerden cuando se celebraba antes de 1970, sino también para las personas más jóvenes que han experimentado y llegado a apreciar la Misa a lo largo de los años. Más recientemente, en julio, el Papa Francisco promulgó un *motu proprio* llamado "Traditionis Custodes" (TC). "Traditionis Custodes" se traduce como "Guardianes de la Tradición". (Un "*motu proprio*" es simplemente un edicto que es promulgado por el Papa por su propia iniciativa). En pocas palabras, el *motu proprio* "SP" del Papa Benedicto XVI liberó la celebración de TML para sacerdotes y fieles, mientras que el *motu proprio* "TC" del Papa Francisco ha puesto algunas restricciones a la celebración de TML.

Sobre todo, con TC, el Papa Francisco subrayó el papel autoritario que los obispos Católicos tienen en sus propias diócesis para garantizar que la TML se celebre fielmente y adecuadamente. En la Diócesis de Sacramento, la TML se celebra todos los días en la Parroquia de San Esteban Primer Mártir, en Sacramento. La Parroquia de San Esteban es servida por sacerdotes de la Fraternidad de San Pedro, una congregación dedicada a la celebración de la TML de acuerdo con el Misal de 1962 y los otros sacramentos bajo la forma tradicional. Hay otra parroquia en la Diócesis de Sacramento donde se celebra la TML (oficialmente) semanalmente los domingos: la Parroquia de Santa María, Vacaville. El Obispo Soto me ha indicado su inclinación a permitir que la TML continúe en nuestra parroquia. Después de todo la TML tiene un historial largo de ser celebrada en Vacaville, ya sea en la Parroquia de Santa María o San José.

Doy este historial de la TML en Vacaville como forma de introducción a la escritura sobre la TML especial que se está organizando para el jueves 21 de octubre a las 6pm. El día 21, tendremos una "Misa Solemne Pontificia (FE/TML)" celebrada por el Arzobispo Salvatore Cordileone de San Francisco. Comenzamos a planear esta Misa hace aproximadamente un año, cuando el feligrés Jason Suárez preguntó si podríamos tratar de tener esta Misa especial. A sugerencia de Jason, decidimos

invitar al arzobispo Cordileone, ya que él ha celebrado este tipo de Misa complicada anteriormente. Por lo tanto, solicité y recibí permiso del Obispo Soto para invitar al Arzobispo Cordileone a nuestra parroquia. Por favor, sepan que son bienvenidos a asistir a esta Misa. Durará más tiempo que una Misa dominical regular, probablemente entre 90 minutos y dos horas. En cualquier forma, planeamos transmitir la Misa en vivo; por lo tanto, estará disponible en nuestra página de YouTube "St. Mary's Vacaville". ¿Por qué tener esta Misa especial el 21 de octubre? El 21 de octubre es la fiesta del Beato Karl de Austria. ¿Quién fue el Beato Karl? Nacido en 1887 en Austria, Karl eventualmente se casó, y junto con su esposa Zita criaron una familia de 8 hijos en la fe católica. Karl y Zita eran Católicos fieles y devotos. En 1916, durante la Primera Guerra Mundial, Karl fue nombrado Emperador de Austria y Rey de Hungría. Fue un gobernante justo, pero solo tres años después, al final de la Primera Guerra Mundial, en 1919, el Beato Karl fue exiliado como resultado de las consecuencias del final de la guerra y el cambio de liderazgo político. Karl sufrió una enfermedad y murió en 1922 en la isla de Madeira, Portugal, a 320 millas al oeste de Marruecos.

En un artículo del *Osservatore Romano* (3 de octubre de 2004), el cardenal Christoph Schönborn, arzobispo de Viena, escribió lo siguiente sobre el beato Karl:

Después de asumir el poder [Karl] se esforzó por aliviar los horrores de la guerra que el veía, y tomó medidas concretas para lograr la paz. Como emperador, entendió que la paz era su deber absoluto y real. En su manifiesto de ascensión, por lo tanto, nombró la paz como su objetivo central. Sólo Karl tomó la propuesta de paz del Papa Benedicto XV, incorporando sus principios en un conjunto de acuerdos de paz propuestos (que los historiadores han evaluado como completamente realistas y que tuvieron un gran potencial). Todos estos esfuerzos fracasaron a largo del tiempo debido al engaño a través de paz -por- victoria decidida por sus aliados políticos alemanes (Hindenburg, Ludendorff) y debido al partido anti-paz del pacto. Karl estaba dispuesto a hacer sacrificios considerables por la paz e, incluso después de su destitución del poder, se esforzó por organizar la paz y la estabilidad de su pueblo y de todas las naciones de Europa. Sus intentos por regresar al poder en Hungría se llevaron a cabo a petición del Papa, que estaba preocupado por la estabilidad y la libertad (¡sus preocupaciones eran justificadas!). El emperador vio su sufrimiento fatal como una ofrenda de sacrificio por la paz y la unidad en Europa Central.

Viviendo en tiempos en que realmente podríamos beneficiarnos de los fieles líderes civiles católicos, el Beato Karl sirve como un buen recordatorio de que se puede lograr el liderazgo político y la santidad. ¡Bendito Karl, ruega por nosotros!

Las Escrituras de hoy señalan el valor de los dones de la sabiduría, la confianza en Dios y dejando que nuestras acciones reflejen el amor de Dios desde nuestro interior. No es el oro lo que nos hace caer, sino más bien el deseo del oro por encima de todas las demás cosas. De las lecturas de la Sabiduría y de la Carta a los Hebreos, encontramos la fuente de los dones de Dios en nuestras vidas. La sabiduría es más valiosa que las posesiones mundanas. En Hebreos se nos reta a examinar nuestros valores y admitir honestamente lo que controla nuestras vidas.
