FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

This week, I will continue the questions and answers about the language in which we pray the Mass and about sacred music.

What else does Vatican II say about sacred music?

Sacrosanctum Concilium (SC), 112 states:

The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value, greater even than that of any other art. The main reason for this pre-eminence is that, as sacred song united to the words, it forms a necessary or integral part of the solemn liturgy [...]. Therefore sacred music is to be considered the more holy in proportion as it is more closely connected with the liturgical action, whether it adds delight to prayer, fosters unity of minds, or confers greater solemnity upon the sacred rites. But the Church approves of all forms of true art having the needed qualities, and admits them into divine worship.

The fact that SC, 112 states that the musical tradition of the Church is “greater even than that of any other art” is a pretty big deal. Think of all the beautiful churches you have seen over the years and throughout the world. Think of all the beautiful sacred paintings and other pieces of art that you have seen. Still, the Church’s musical tradition is greater than all of these. Why? Because when the song and the words are put together, it is integral to the liturgy. In other words, while the beauty of the architecture and the church building are certainly important elements of the Mass, they are not the most important. They are not integral to the Mass. But the way the prayers of the Mass are prayed, chanted or sung is integral and therefore “greater than that of any other art”. It seems to me, then, that the type of music we use at Mass should really be quite different from any other music. To be sure, music for the Mass should not be secular music. It should be sacred or “set aside” in a special way for the celebration of Mass.

SC, 114 adds the following: “The treasure of sacred music is to be preserved and fostered with great care.” Like anything else, but especially when dealing with the way we pray, if something is beautiful and valuable, we want to preserve it and foster it. If one has a really nice car, one takes good care of it. If one has a beautiful and costly violin, one makes sure it is protected from the elements. Even more so with sacred music. It is “to be preserved and fostered with great care”.

Then, what sort of music should be used at Mass?

SC, 116 states:

The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as especially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.

Gregorian chant “should be given pride of place in liturgical services”. In this way, we see that if we are really trying to celebrate and pray the Mass according to the Second Vatican Council, we would be praying the way that these key paragraphs of *Sacrosanctum Concilium* indicate. That’s what we are trying to do at St. Mary’s Parish.

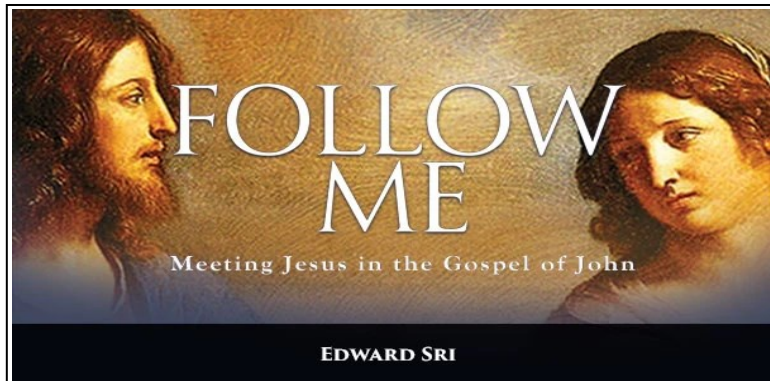

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Esta semana, continuaré las preguntas y respuestas sobre el lenguaje en el que rezamos la Misa y sobre la música sagrada.

¿Qué más dice el Vaticano II sobre la música sagrada?
Sacrosanctum Concilium (SC), 112 afirma:

La tradición musical de la Iglesia universal constituye un tesoro de valor inestimable, que sobresale entre las demás expresiones artísticas, principalmente porque el canto sagrado, unido a las palabras, constituye una parte necesaria o integral de la Liturgia solemne[....]

La música sacra, por consiguiente, será tanto más santa cuanto más íntimamente esté unida a la acción litúrgica, ya sea expresando con mayor delicadeza la oración o fomentando la unanimidad, ya sea enriqueciendo la mayor solemnidad los ritos sagrados. Además, la Iglesia aprueba y admite en el culto divino todas las formas de arte auténtico que estén adornadas de las debidas cualidades.

El hecho de que SC, 112 afirma que la tradición musical de la Iglesia es "sobresale entre las demás expresiones artísticas" es una gran cosa. Piensa en todas las hermosas iglesias que has visto a lo largo de los años y por todo el mundo. Piensa en todas las hermosas pinturas sagradas y otras obras de arte que has visto. Aún así, la tradición musical de la Iglesia es mayor que todas estas. ¿Por qué? Porque cuando el canto y las palabras se juntan, es parte integral de la liturgia. En otras palabras, si bien la belleza de la arquitectura y el edificio de la iglesia son ciertamente elementos importantes de la Misa, no son los más importantes. No son parte integral de la Misa. Pero la forma en que se rezan y se cantan las oraciones de la Misa es integral y, por lo tanto, "sobresale entre las demás expresiones artísticas". Me parece, entonces, que el tipo de música que usamos en la Misa debería ser realmente muy diferente de cualquier otra música. Sin duda, la música para la Misa no debe ser música secular. Debe ser sagrada o "separada" de una manera especial para la celebración de la Misa.

SC, 114 agrega lo siguiente: Consérvese y cultívese con sumo cuidado el tesoro de la música sacra. Como cualquier otra cosa, pero especialmente cuando se trata con la manera que oramos, si algo es hermoso y valioso, queremos preservarlo y cultivarlo. Si tengo un carro hermoso, lo cuido. Si tengo un violín hermoso y valioso, me aseguro de prote-

protegerlo de los elementos. Aun más con la música sagrada. Es "para preservarla y cultivarla con gran cuidado".

Entonces, ¿qué tipo de música se debe usar en la Misa?
SC, 116 establece:

La Iglesia reconoce el canto gregoriano como el propio de la liturgia romana; en igualdad de circunstancias, por tanto, hay que darle el primer lugar en las acciones litúrgicas.

El canto gregoriano "debe tener un lugar de honor en los servicios litúrgicos". De esta manera, vemos que si realmente estamos tratando de celebrar y rezar la Misa de acuerdo con el Concilio Vaticano II, estaríamos orando de la manera que indican estos párrafos clave de Sacrosanctum Concilium. Eso es lo que estamos tratando de hacer en la parroquia de Santa María.
